

# **Sage Family Genealogical Report (Sample)**

*Note: Despite having completed several years' worth of personal genealogical research and professional research for various internships, I have never been asked to create a narrative report. I have modeled this sample report after documents that I have worked with in the past and the genealogy citations based on the Genealogy Appendix to the Hanover College Style Sheet for Chicago Manual Footnotes. I have also attached two sample biographies that I wrote for my graduate fellowship at Fort Ticonderoga to showcase the typical style in which I have presented my genealogical research. Thank you for your consideration.*

## ***Origin***

**Benoni Benjamin Sage (1703-1734)** was born on April 5<sup>th</sup>, 1703 in Middletown, Connecticut to parents John Sage (1688-1750) and Hannah Starr (1674-1753).<sup>i</sup> He was baptized on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 1703.<sup>ii</sup> He married **Mary Allen (1700-)** on February 5<sup>th</sup>, 1724 in Middletown.<sup>iii</sup> She was born August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1700 in Milford, Connecticut to parents Henry Allen and Mercy Mary Tibbals.<sup>iv</sup> The couple raised their children in Connecticut. Benoni died on January 12<sup>th</sup>, 1734 in Middletown.<sup>v</sup>

v. ***Benoni Sage (1734-1735)***, born on January 12<sup>th</sup>, 1734, the same day his father died.<sup>xi</sup> He died young, likely in 1735.

## ***Generation 1***

**1 - Benjamin Sage (1725-1813)** was born on January 17<sup>th</sup>, 1725 in Berlin, Connecticut to parents Benoni Benjamin Sage and Mary Allen.<sup>xii</sup> He married **Abigail Blinn (1725-)** on August 2, 1744 in Middletown, Connecticut.<sup>xiii</sup> She was born in 1725 in Wethersfield, Connecticut to parents Jonathan and Mary Blinn.<sup>xiv</sup> Benjamin signed the Association Test of Dutchess County, New York in 1775 to prove his loyalty to the American Patriots' cause during the American Revolution.<sup>xv</sup> He served as a private in the Revolutionary War under Captain Husted in Colonel Henry van Rensselaer's regiment of New York State Troops.<sup>xvi</sup> He died on December 8<sup>th</sup>, 1813 in Mumford, New York and was buried in Wheatland Baptist Cemetery.<sup>xvii</sup>

**2 - Daniel Sage (1727-)** was born on April 17<sup>th</sup>, 1727 in Middletown, Connecticut to parents Benoni Benjamin Sage and Mary Allen.<sup>xxiii</sup>

**3 - Lt. Allen Sage (1730-1790)** was born on February 1<sup>st</sup>, 1730 in Middletown, Connecticut to parents Benoni Benjamin Sage and Mary Allen.<sup>xxiv</sup> He married **Abigail Willard (1732-)** on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1750 in Cromwell, Connecticut.<sup>xxv</sup> She was born on September 24<sup>th</sup>, 1732 in Guilford, Connecticut to parents Daniel and Thankful Willard.<sup>xxvi</sup> Allen served in the Revolutionary War starting in Captain Rufus Herrick's Company in the 4<sup>th</sup> New York Regiment under the command of Colonel James Holmes.<sup>xxvii</sup> Between June 28<sup>th</sup> and October 9<sup>th</sup>, 1775, he was listed in the muster roll at camp in Ticonderoga. He was then sent to Albany, sick. At a later date, he achieved the rank of lieutenant. He died around 1790.

## **Generation 2**

**4 - Benjamin Sage (1754-1784)** was born on December 19<sup>th</sup>, 1754 in Middletown, Connecticut to parents Benjamin Sage and Abigail Blinn.<sup>xxxii</sup> He married **Hannah Randall (1755-)**.<sup>xxxiii</sup> She was born on March 6<sup>th</sup>, 1755 in Sharon, Connecticut to parents John and Lois Randall.<sup>xxxiv</sup> Benjamin enlisted in the Revolutionary Army during the American Revolution, starting as a private under Captain Husted.<sup>xxxv</sup> He later served in Henry K. Van Rensselaer's Regiment of the New York Militia.<sup>xxxvi</sup> Records show that he was with Benedict Arnold in the Quebec Expedition and "endured unspeakable sufferings in the retreat from Canada."<sup>xxxvii</sup> Benjamin was also with Connecticut troops under General Gates at the time of General Burgoyne's surrender in October 1777. Due to the effects of hardships endured during his service, he died shortly after the war in 1784 in Rensselaerville, New York.<sup>xxxviii</sup>

**5 - Daniel Sage (1756-1852)** was born on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 1756 in Berlin, Connecticut to parents Benjamin Sage and Abigail Blinn.<sup>xli</sup> He was baptized on December 26<sup>th</sup> of the same year.<sup>xlii</sup>

Daniel served in the Revolutionary War as a Patriot. He first enlisted for three months with the Company of Captain Wright of Vermont in late 1775.<sup>xliii</sup> By late December, he had marched with the Company through the western parts of Connecticut and Massachusetts and through Skenesborough in Vermont, on to Ticonderoga, Crown Point, St. Johns, and Montreal. When he reached Quebec after the Battle of Quebec at the dawn of 1776, he re-enlisted there to continue service in Canada. Daniel was stationed most of the time on Abraham's Plains until the end of April 1776 when he enlisted again a few days before the American army was forced to retreat from Canada. While a member of the Company of Captain Wheeler and the Regiment of Colonel Porter of Massachusetts, he retreated from Canada alongside his brother's regiment. Daniel's regiment then regrouped at Fort Ticonderoga and Mount Independence, keeping sentry and building forts into the fall. He and the others left Ticonderoga in late fall 1776 and moved to Fishkill, New York. He remained there until the end of January or early February 1777, after which he was discharged. Daniel re-enlisted a final time in fall 1777 under Captain Waters, Lieutenant Darrow, and Colonel Sutherland. His regiment marched along the Hudson River to Esopus. He was on duty around that area until his two-month term ended and he was discharged at Fishkill in December 1776. He completed his military service with the rank of Sergeant Major.<sup>xliv</sup>

Daniel married **Sybel Jewett** (1760-1822) in 1778.<sup>xlv</sup> She was born on April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1760 to parents Caleb and Rebecca Jewett.<sup>xlvi</sup> She died on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 1822 in South New Berlin, New York. At some point after the Revolutionary War, Daniel moved from Sharon, Connecticut to Rensselaerville, New York. The couple stayed there until 1795 when they moved to South New Berlin, New York. Daniel remained there until he died on December 17<sup>th</sup>, 1852.<sup>xlvii</sup>

**6 - Harlehigh H. Sage (1766-1828)** was born on November 27<sup>th</sup>, 1766 in Cromwell, Connecticut to parents Benjamin Sage and Abigail Blinn.<sup>lxi</sup> In 1780 during the Revolutionary War, he enlisted in the Patriot army. He primarily served as a private in Captain David Strong's company in Colonel Bradley's regiment in Huntington's brigade.<sup>lxii</sup> He transferred to Colonel Johnson's Connecticut regiment before his discharge in January 1782.<sup>lxiii</sup> After the war, Harlehigh had a first wife, whose name is unknown. He moved to Ohio around 1811 and married **Lucinda Staige Pratt (1776-1866)**, his second wife, on January 18<sup>th</sup>, 1812 in Pickaway, Ohio.<sup>lxiv</sup> She was born in 1777 in Virginia to parents Richard Thomas and Sarah Staige and died on August 12<sup>th</sup>, 1866.<sup>lxv</sup> She was previously married to William Pratt, who also served in the Revolutionary War.<sup>lxvi</sup>

Harlehigh and Lucinda remained in Pickaway County for the duration of their marriage. He died on January 8<sup>th</sup>, 1828 in Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio.<sup>lxvii</sup>

**13 - Benjamin Sage (1774-1805)** was born in 1774 in Granville, New York to Benjamin Sage and Hannah Randall.<sup>cxv</sup> He married **Elizabeth Rachel Bennett (1783-1826)** on November 21<sup>st</sup>, 1799 in Pawlet, Vermont.<sup>cxvi</sup> She was born in 1783 and died in 1826. In 1805, Benjamin was found guilty of perjury "by swearing falsely to an account of 40 dollars, against a [neighbor] whom he owed a grudge."<sup>cxvii</sup> Because of this, he died on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 1805 in Pawlet by his own hand.<sup>cxviii</sup>
